\_\_\_ **Undergraduate Curriculum Committee:** This committee is chaired by a Faculty Department chair and attended by the Provost and Dean of the College, the Dean of Students, select faculty and staff members and an undergraduate student senator. The Committee meets **the second Wednesday of each month from 10:10-12noon** to discuss new course proposals and potential changes to the curriculum.

\_\_\_ **Graduate Curriculum Committee:** This committee is chaired by a Faculty Department chair and attended by the Provost and Dean of the College, the Dean of Students, select faculty and staff members and a graduate student Senator. The Committee meets **the second Wednesday of each month from 8:30-10am** to discuss new course proposals and potential changes to the curriculum.

\_\_\_ **Student Affairs Committee:** This committee is comprised of the Dean of Students and Assistant Dean of Campus Life (co-chairs), the Provost, the Chair of the Board, select members of NEC's senior administration and 3 student Senators (ideally, an undergraduate, a graduate and an international student). The Committee meets for lunch three times each academic year (**October, January, April from 12-1:30**) to address student concerns and showcase new initiatives.

\_\_\_ **Disciplinary Committee:** This committee is chaired by the Dean or Associate Dean of Students and attended by two faculty members, the Assistant Dean of Campus Life, a Res Life Staff Member, a Student Senator and the department chair of the student involved in the hearing. The Committee meets on an as-needed basis to determine if a violation of the NEC disciplinary code has occurred, and if so, how to resolve the matter. Violations include academic dishonesty, violation of Residence Hall rules, theft or destruction of property, and harassment of any member of the NEC community.
