TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The preferred method of payment for the New England Conservatory of Music is through the Federal Automated Clearing House system, commonly known as ACH or direct deposit. ACH is known to be one of the safest, fastest and most convenient methods of payment. To enroll in the ACH payment process, you must have a valid checking account at a financial institution that participates in ACH (almost all banks and credit unions participate).

In order to successfully enroll to receive your payments by ACH you agree:

- 1. To the provisions of this ACH agreement;
- 2. To provide complete and accurate enrollment information;
- 3. That any revised authorizations will replace any previous authorization;
- 4. That New England Conservatory may reverse any duplicate or erroneous credit entries;
- 5. That your authorization shall remain valid until it is terminated or revoked in writing or by the closing of the recipient's account at the receiving financial institution;
- 6. Submission of the ACH Payment Enrollment Form authorizes New England Conservatory to electronically deposit your payments through ACH to the financial institution you have listed on this form;
- 7. Your authorization shall remain in effect until written notice of change or termination is provided to New England Conservatory;
- 8. Any such notice will afford New England Conservatory and the financial institution named reasonable opportunity to act on it; and
- 9. It is your responsibility to provide an updated Vendor/Supplier ACH Payment Enrollment and Update Form should there be a need to change any of the information contained on this form essential to completing payments to you, or for timely and accurate administration thereof.
