An accomplished soprano, she sang spiritual hymns at events where her husband Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. spoke, and both curated and performed at the renowned Freedom Concerts, combining music, prose and poetry narration.

In celebrating Mrs. King, BSU wishes to continue her activism in their advocacy for equal opportunity and representation for our black students.

This year, CSK features accomplished composer and trumpeter Forbes Graham, poet Vanessa Silva, as well as members of the BSU student body.
